

Information pursuant to EU Regulation 2016/679 ("GDPR")

WHY THIS NOTICE

This information will allow you to know in detail how the personal data you provide to us when you fill in the form to use the services offered by the Trieste Passenger Terminal will be processed.

WHO IS THE DATA CONTROLLER

Trieste Terminal Passeggeri S.P.A. is the data controller of your personal data.

WHAT TYPE AND NATURE OF DATA ARE PROCESSED

When you fill in the form on the site personal data will be collected, or data that allow your identification, even indirectly, such as name, surname, address, email, data of the vehicle used, or other data that you provide spontaneously when filling in the free space.

DATA OF MINORS UNDER 16 YEARS

Minors under the age of 16 are not allowed to provide any personal data, nor to register on the site. If it is ascertained that the statements made are untrue, all data received will be deleted.

PURPOSES AND LEGAL BASES FOR THE LEGALITY OF PROCESSING

The data collected will be used for the following purposes:

- to allow us to release information upon your request.
- to carry out the requested service.

Data of a common nature may be processed even without your specific consent, in order to satisfy your requests and for the pre-contractual and contractual purposes connected with and instrumental to the requested service, as well as to fulfil the related legal obligations to which the Data Controller is subject.

You are free to provide your data or not, but in the absence of the requested data it will not be possible to conclude or carry out the service and your requests.

METHOD AND PLACE OF PROCESSING AND RETENTION PERIOD

Your data are processed at our head office, using telematic, paper, electronic or automated means, and this is carried out by authorised and trained persons within the limits of the duties assigned to them, for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected.

In particular, your data will be retained for the duration of any contract and, subsequently, for the time necessary to comply with tax obligations, or for other purposes contemplated by law or regulation. In the absence of a contract, the data will be deleted 12 months after collection.

COMMUNICATION AND DISCLOSURE OF DATA

Your personal data may be communicated to the following categories of subjects:

- a) to our suppliers with whom we collaborate and to companies that manage payments (PayPal) to provide you with the requested service;
- b) to companies that provide data processing and IT services, professionals, consultancy companies or firms, companies operating in the supply of services for the execution of the contract.

These subjects will act as autonomous Data Controllers, or will be appointed as Data Processors by means of a specific contract or legal deed.

The data may also be accessed by persons who are granted this right by law or regulations (e.g. public safety authorities).

The data will not be subject to automated decision-making or profiling of any kind.

Personal data will not be disclosed, nor will they be transferred to third countries or international organisations.

RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

The rights granted to you include the rights to:

- request access to your personal data and information about them; rectify inaccurate data or integrate incomplete data; delete personal data (if any of the conditions set out in art. 17, paragraph 1 of the GDPR are met and in compliance with the exceptions set out in paragraph 3 of the same article); limit

the processing of personal data (if any one of the conditions set out in article 18, paragraph 1 of the GDPR applies);

- request and obtain - in the event that the legal basis of the processing is the contract or consent, and the same is carried out by automated means - personal data in a structured format, readable by an automatic device, also in order to communicate said data to another data controller (the so-called right to portability of personal data);
- object at any time to the processing of personal data, including profiling, when special situations occur relating to them;
- withdraw consent at any time, limited to cases where processing is based on consent for one or more specific purposes and relates to common personal data (e.g. date and place of birth or place of residence) or to particular categories of data (e.g. data revealing health or sex life). However, the processing based on consent and carried out prior to the revocation of the same remains lawful;

If you believe that there is a breach in the processing of your personal data, you can lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority of the place where you habitually reside, work or where the alleged breach occurred. We inform you that in Italy you can lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority.
